Cancellation of Public Hearing Notice

The **Committee on Housing, Neighborhood Development and The Homeless** of the Council of the City of Philadelphia **has CANCELLED** a Public Hearing on **Friday, December 6, 2024**, at **10:00 AM**, in **Room 400, City Hall**, to hear testimony on the following items:

- 240697** Resolution authorizing the Committee on Housing, Neighborhood Development, and the Homeless to hold hearings on how setting affordable housing program eligibility according to the metric of regional Area Median Income (AMI) fails to reflect the true state of housing affordability needs of Philadelphians, how this leads to City housing programs not providing enough funding to those who need it most, and how the adoption of a more locally defined AMI can be utilized to create and sustain genuinely affordable housing across the City of Philadelphia.
