Recognizing and Congratulating the Epsilon Delta Chapter of Delta Sigma Theta Sorority Incorporated at Temple University on the 50th Anniversary.

WHEREAS, The first public act performed by the Delta Founders involved their participation in the Women's Suffrage March in Washington D.C., March 1913; and
