## Public Hearing Notice

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The **Committee on Streets and Services** of the Council of the City of Philadelphia will hold a Public Hearing on **Tuesday, March 24, 2009, at 10:00 AM, in Room 400, City Hall**, to hear testimony on the following items:

- 080645** An Ordinance amending Chapter 12-1100 of The Philadelphia Code, entitled "Miscellaneous Regulations and Penalties," by adding a new section prohibiting the use of a hand-held mobile telephone by a person operating a motor vehicle or other vehicle on a City street, under certain terms and conditions.
- 090001** An Ordinance authorizing Hossein Elbanna to construct, own and maintain, an open-air sidewalk cafe at 3901 Walnut Street, under certain terms and conditions.
- 090002** An Ordinance authorizing Hardev Singh to construct, own and maintain, an open-air sidewalk cafe and planters at 4004 Chestnut Street, under certain terms and conditions.
- 090008** An Ordinance authorizing Tony Elebah to construct, own and maintain, an open-air sidewalk cafe at 2457-2459 North 54th Street, under certain terms and conditions.
- 090009** An Ordinance establishing a parking regulation on 27th street, west side, Allegheny avenue to Clearfield street.
- 090010** An Ordinance establishing a parking regulation on Arnold street, west side, Midvale avenue to No Outlet.
- 090011** An Ordinance establishing a parking regulation on Hirst street, west side, Arch street to Market street.
- 090013** An Ordinance amending Section 12-918 of The Philadelphia Code, entitled "Parking for Car Sharing Organizations," by adding locations, all under certain terms and conditions.
- 090014** An Ordinance amending the provisions of Section 12-918 of The Philadelphia Code, which regulates the provision of on-street parking restricted to vehicles owned by car sharing organizations.
- 090015** An Ordinance amending Section 9-212 of The Philadelphia Code, entitled "Newsstands," to permit the placement of commercial advertising on newsstands and revise the fee for a newsstand license, all under certain terms and conditions.
- 090017** An Ordinance establishing a parking regulation on Moore street, both sides, 12th street to 13th street.

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- 090018** An Ordinance establishing a parking regulation on Morris street, both sides, Broad street to 13th street.
- 090019** An Ordinance establishing a parking regulation on Ellsworth street, both sides, 12th street to 11th street.
- 090020** An Ordinance establishing a parking regulation on Federal street, both sides, 12th street to 13th street.
- 090021** An Ordinance establishing a parking regulation on Clarion street, west side, Federal street to No Outlet.
- 090022** An Ordinance establishing a parking regulation on Sartain street, east side, McKean street to Mifflin street.
- 090023** An Ordinance establishing a parking regulation on 7th street, both sides, Carpenter street to Christian street.
- 090024** An Ordinance establishing a parking regulation on Packer avenue, north side, 16th street to 17th street.
- 090025** An Ordinance establishing a parking regulation on Tasker street, north side, 11th street to 12th street.
- 090026** An Ordinance establishing a parking regulation on Darrah street, both sides, Brill street to Bridge street.
- 090070** An Ordinance authorizing the paving of Keely Street from Henry Avenue southwestwardly to a cul-de-sac turnaround, under certain terms and conditions.
- 090076** An Ordinance authorizing the revision of lines and grades on a portion of City Plan No. 63 by relocating the northerly houseline and curbline of Harmer Street, from Fifteenth Street to Sixteenth Street; authorizing the dedication to the City of the privately-owned widened portion of Harmer Street; and authorizing the opening of the widened Harmer Street, including a portion owned by the City; all under certain terms and conditions.
- 090120** An Ordinance authorizing the revision of lines and grades on a portion of City Plan Nos. 107 and 130 by striking from the City Plan and vacating the legally open portions of Forty-seventh Street from Fairmount Avenue to Brown Street; striking from the City Plan and vacating Aspen Street from Forty-seventh Street to Markoe Street; and reserving on the City Plan, and authorizing City acceptance of rights-of-way for various purposes within the lines of Forty-seventh Street and Aspen Street being stricken; all under certain terms and conditions.

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- 090121** An Ordinance establishing a no truck parking regulation on the 5200 block of Marshall street, from Fisher avenue to Duncannon avenue, on the eastern side.
- 090122** An Ordinance amending Section 9-604 of The Philadelphia Code, entitled "Refuse Collection," by increasing the annual license fee for the various licenses required by that Section, including the Private Garbage Collection License, the Waste Collection License, and the Recyclable Material Collection License, all under certain terms and conditions.
- 090123** An Ordinance amending the provisions of The Philadelphia Code regulating dumpsters; in particular, repealing and reenacting the provisions of Section 10-722, entitled "Use of Dumpsters"; amending Section 9-604, entitled "Refuse Collection," to provide that persons licensed under that Section who own, rent or control dumpsters shall comply with all provisions of the new Section 10-722, and making compliance with such provisions a condition of the Garbage Collection License, the Waste Collection License, and the Recyclable Material Collection License, a condition that may be enforced by license revocation; amending the enforcement and penalty provision of Sections 10-718 and 10-719 relating to fines, penalties, and forfeitures for violations of the new Section 10-722; and amending Section 11-605, entitled "Construction Materials," to revise the provisions regulating construction dumpsters and Section 11-609, entitled "Administrative Provisions," to increase the fines for violations of Section 11-605; all under certain terms and conditions.
- 090126** An Ordinance authorizing Manuel C. & Maria E. Terrivel to construct, own and maintain an open-air sidewalk café at 1801 S. 4th Street, under certain terms and conditions.
- 090129** An Ordinance establishing a no truck parking regulation on both sides of N. Hancock Street between Jefferson Street and Thompson Street.

Immediately following the public hearing, a meeting of the Committee on Streets and Services, open to the public, will be held to consider the action to be taken on the above listed items.
