## AN ORDINANCE

Amending Section 12-701 of The Philadelphia Code, entitled “Designation of Bicycle Lanes,” to authorize a bicycle lane on South 59th Street from Market Street to Baltimore Avenue, and the removal of a travel lane within the same limits, all under certain terms and conditions.

*THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PHILADELPHIA HEREBY ORDAINS:*

SECTION 1. Section 12-701 of The Philadelphia Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

### TITLE 12. TRAFFIC CODE

### CHAPTER 12-700. BICYCLE LANES

§ 12-701. Designation of Bicycle Lanes.

\* \* \*

(2) The Department is authorized to designate a bicycle lane upon the following streets and regulate the operation and use of vehicles and bicycles upon such streets in a manner consistent with Pennsylvania Department of Transportation (PennDOT) regulations:

(\*) *59th Street from Market Street to Baltimore Avenue, and removal of a travel lane within the same limits.*

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately.
