Public Hearing Notice

The **Committee on Parks, Recreation and Cultural Affairs** of the Council of the City of Philadelphia will hold a Public Hearing on **Tuesday, October 30, 2007**, at **1:00 PM**, in **Room 400, City Hall**, to hear testimony on the following items:

- 070213** Resolution authorizing City Council's Committee on Parks, Recreation and Cultural Affairs to determine the feasibility of the Department of Parks and Recreation partnering with the Philadelphia School Board for the purpose of developing community run recreation programs in public school facilities to be used after hours; such community run recreation programs would be sponsored and run by the Parks and Recreation Department.
- 070292** Resolution authorizing City Council's Committee on Parks, Recreation and Cultural Affairs to determine the feasibility of installing surveillance cameras in all of the recreational facilities, as a means to further enhance the safety of all persons utilizing these facilities; and as a means to fight crime and violence in these facilities.

Immediately following the public hearing, a meeting of the Committee on Parks, Recreation and Cultural Affairs, open to the public, will be held to consider the action to be taken on the above listed items.
