RESOLUTION

Recognizing the week of November 8, 2021 as Global Entrepreneurship Week (“GEW”) and celebrating the small business community and the impact of the entrepreneurial spirit on Philadelphia’s economy.

WHEREAS, The week of November 8, 2021 is recognized as Global Entrepreneurship Week; and

WHEREAS, Global Entrepreneurship Week is the world’s largest celebration of the innovators and job creators who launch startups, bringing ideas to life, driving economic growth and expanding human welfare; and

WHEREAS, Entrepreneurs lead Philadelphia’s job growth efforts. As our small businesses expand, they employ Philadelphians in the neighborhoods they live in and improve the quality of life of individuals and communities across the City; and

WHEREAS, Global Entrepreneurship Week is a celebration of collaboration.
