AN ORDINANCE

Amending Section 9-205 of The Philadelphia Code, entitled “Sidewalk Sales,” by exempting sidewalk sales by owners and tenants of properties on both sides of Twenty-second street, between Lehigh avenue and Allegheny avenue, and by permitting such activity under certain terms and conditions.

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PHILADELPHIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

SECTION 1. Section 9-205 of The Philadelphia Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

TITLE 9. REGULATION OF BUSINESSES, TRADES AND PROFESSIONS.

CHAPTER 9-200. COMMERCIAL ACTIVITIES ON STREETS.

§9-205. Sidewalk Sales.

(2) Exemptions. The provisions of this Section shall not apply to:

(e) Subsection (d) shall apply to owners and tenants of properties at the following locations:

(.3) *Both sides of Twenty-second street between Lehigh avenue and Allegheny avenue.*

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon becoming law.
