## AN ORDINANCE

Authorizing the paving of Gaskill street and Philip street, under certain terms and conditions.

## THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PHILADELPHIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

**SECTION 1**. The Procurement Commissioner, pursuant to the provision of Sections 11-502 and 11-503 of The Philadelphia Code, is hereby authorized to enter into a contract for the paving of Gaskill street from Third street to a point approximately two hundred eighty-four (284) feet eastwardly therefrom, and Philip street from Lombard street to a point approximately one hundred forty-three (143) feet southwardly therefrom.

**SECTION 2**. In lieu of the provisions of Section 1, the party in interest shall file an agreement and bond with corporate surety, satisfactory to the Law Department and in an amount determined by the Streets Department, to cover the cost of the work required to completely pave Gaskill street and Philip street at his sole cost and expense in accordance with the specifications and requirements of the City of Philadelphia.

**SECTION 3**. This Ordinance shall not become effective unless the sum of two hundred dollars (\$200.00), toward the cost thereof, is paid into the City Treasury within sixty (60) days after this Ordinance becomes law.
