The Committee on Public Health and Human Services of the Council of the City of Philadelphia will hold a Public Hearing on Tuesday, October 25, 2011, at 1:00 PM, in Room 400, City Hall, to hear testimony on the following items:

An Ordinance amending Section 10-602 of The Philadelphia Code, known as the

"Clean Indoor Air Worker Protection Law," by providing a limited period of time, expiring January 1, 2012, during which certain Drinking Establishments, as defined, may apply for and obtain a waiver of the provisions of the Section

prohibiting smoking in certain places, under certain terms and conditions.

An Ordinance amending Chapter 10-100 of The Philadelphia Code, entitled

"Animals," to establish provisions for the reporting of wild raccoons, and to

provide for the manner of their abatement, all under certain terms and conditions.

Immediately following the public hearing, a meeting of the Committee on Public Health and Human Services, open to the public, will be held to consider the action to be taken on the above listed items.
