051106	An Ordinance amending Title 12 of The Philadelphia Code, entitled "Traffic Code," to provide for conditions on enforcement of prohibitions on parking a vehicle if the vehicle is not registered or not displaying a valid registration plate; all under certain terms and conditions.
051107	An Ordinance amending Chapter 12-3000 of The Philadelphia Code, entitled "Use Of An Automated Red Light Enforcement System To Prevent Red Light Violations," by amending limitations on the use of information collected under the red light enforcement system, all under certain terms and conditions.
051140	An Ordinance authorizing and directing the revision of lines and grades on a portion of City Plan Nos. 356 and 378 by striking from the City Plan the Industrial Highway from the Philadelphia-Delaware County Line to Island Avenue, and by reserving and placing on the City Plan a certain right-of-way within the bed of the Industrial Highway for drainage purposes, water main purposes, gas main purposes and public utility purposes, if needed, under certain terms and conditions.
051145	An Ordinance regulating the movement of traffic on Chestnut street; in particular, authorizing right turns to be made from Chestnut street at certain intersections in Center City Philadelphia.
051201	An Ordinance authorizing and directing the revision of lines and grades on a portion of City Plan No. 298 by extending Almatt Place approximately 105', placing this extension of Almatt Place and a new cul-de-sac at the resultant dead-end turnaround, and striking and vacating those portions of the former cul-de-sac of Almatt Place lying outside the lines of the newly extended Almatt Place, under certain terms and conditions, including the dedication to the City, free and clear of all encumbrances, of the bed of Almatt Place extended.
051202	An Ordinance authorizing the paving of the extension of Almatt Place, under certain terms and conditions.

Immediately following the public he aring, a meeting of the Committee on Streets and Services, open to the public, will be held to consider the action to be taken on the above listed items.
