WHEREAS, Players from SEYAA have not only gone on to play high school and college sports, but also have become professional Basketball players; played on winning Super Bowl teams or have been drafted by Major League Baseball teams; and

WHEREAS, SEYAA's Mission Statement from the beginning was to strive to give every child in the community an opportunity to be involved in sporting activities on a year-round basis- no matter what their skill level; and

WHEREAS, It has always been SEYAA's goal to provide their participants with the best equipment, the best sporting facilities, and the best fields all in one location. The SEYAA fields are very important not only for sports but in the development of each child. By instilling good sportsmanship, discipline, dedication, social skills, listening, learning, and fun. This leads to memories and great childhood experiences as well as helps the children grow into responsible, social, and disciplined adults.
