AN ORDINANCE

Establishing parking regulations in the vicinity of: Dauphin street and Belgrade street; Almond street and Dauphin street; York street and Almond street; Taggart street and Norris street; Cedar street and Norris street; Marlborough street and Thompson street.

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PHILADELPHIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

SECTION 1. The following parking regulation is hereby established:

Two Hour Parking
8:00 AM – 8:00 PM
Monday – Sunday
Except RPP#25

Dauphin street, both sides, Belgrade street to Almond street

SECTION 2. The following parking regulation is hereby established:

Two Hour Parking
4:00 PM – 2:00 AM
Monday – Sunday
Except RPP# 25

Almond street, both sides, Dauphin street to Norris street

SECTION 3. The following parking regulation is hereby established:

Two Hour Parking
4:30 PM – 2:00 AM
Monday – Sunday
Except RPP# 25

York street, both sides, Almond street to Gaul street
