In compliance with the Pennsylvania Sunshine Act, Act 93, 1998, the **Committee on Streets and Services** of the Council of the City of Philadelphia will hold a Public Hearing **Tuesday, June 7, 2005**, at **10:00 AM**, in **Room 400**, City Hall, to hear testimony on the following items:

- 050511** An Ordinance amending Chapter 9-200 of The Philadelphia Code, entitled "Commercial Activity on Streets," by amending Section 9-204, entitled "Sidewalk Vendors in Center City," by providing for additional exemptions on South street, all under certain terms and conditions.
- 050512** An Ordinance authorizing the Water Commissioner on behalf of the City to enter into an agreement with the owners of the properties and their successors at 1500 South Front Street for the grant of an "L" shaped right-of-way to the City through the property from Front Street to Dickinson Street for drainage, sewer and water main purposes, under certain terms and conditions.
- 050514** An Ordinance authorizing and directing the revision of lines and grades on a portion of City Plan No. 307 by relocating the westerly curb line and house line of Fifteenth Street between Arch Street and Cherry Street, under certain terms and conditions.
- 050516** An Ordinance authorizing and directing the revision of lines and grades on a portion of City Plan No. 120 by striking from the City Plan and vacating Harlan Street, Stewart Street and Nassau Street, each from 21st Street to 22nd Street, and by reserving and placing on the City Plan a right-of-way for gas main purposes within the beds of Stewart Street and Nassau Street being stricken under authority of this Ordinance, all under certain terms and conditions.
- 050517** An Ordinance authorizing the paving of Uber Street, under certain terms and conditions.

Immediately following the public hearing, a meeting of the Committee on Streets and Services, open to the public, will be held to consider the action to be taken on the above listed items.
