Public Hearing Notice

The **Committee on Public Safety** of the Council of the City of Philadelphia will hold a Public Hearing on **Monday, June 8, 2015**, at **1:00 PM**, in **Room 400, City Hall**, to hear testimony on the following items:

- 150096** An Ordinance amending Section 9-703 of The Philadelphia Code, entitled "Special Assembly Occupancies," to add additional requirements relating to surveillance cameras; all under certain terms and conditions.
- 150107** Resolution authorizing the Committee on Public Safety to conduct hearings to explore new methods to increase surveillance cameras throughout the City that satisfy the guidelines of the Philadelphia Police Department Safety Cam Program, such as a tax abatement to offset the cost for camera installation and mandatory camera installation for nuisance businesses, among other initiatives, in order to increase efforts to reduce crime and promote public safety in the City of Philadelphia.

Immediately following the public hearing, a meeting of the Committee on Public Safety, open to the public, will be held to consider the action to be taken on the above listed items.
