Public Hearing Notice

The **Committee on Transportation and Public Utilities** of the Council of the City of Philadelphia will hold a Public Hearing on **Monday, January 30, 2017**, at **1:00 PM**, in **Room 400, City Hall**, to hear testimony on the following items:

- 161058** An Ordinance adopting an amendment to the Articles of Incorporation of the Philadelphia Energy Authority ("Authority") increasing the number of members on the Authority's Board from five to seven, as proposed by the Board in a Resolution adopted November 30, 2016.
- 160798** Resolution authorizing Council's Committee on Transportation and Public Utilities to hold hearings concerning the adequacy, safety and consistency of SEPTA's CCT system which provides paratransit services to individuals with disabilities and senior citizens.

Immediately following the public hearing, a meeting of the Committee on Transportation and Public Utilities, open to the public, will be held to consider the action to be taken on the above listed items.
