The **Committee on the Environment** of the Council of the City of Philadelphia will hold a Public Hearing on **Monday, April 11, 2016**, at **1:00 PM**, in **Room 400, City Hall**, to hear testimony on the following items:

- 160110** An Ordinance amending Chapter 17-600 of The Philadelphia Code, entitled "Procurement Price Preferences," by adding a preference for alternatives to expanded polystyrene, under certain terms and conditions.
- 160211** Resolution authorizing the Committee on the Environment to hold hearings to examine the Solar Schools for Philadelphia report released by PennEnvironment Research & Policy Center and Frontier Group, and to investigate financing options for the School District of Philadelphia to use its land and building stock for solar energy generation.

Immediately following the public hearing, a meeting of the Committee on the Environment, open to the public, will be held to consider the action to be taken on the above listed items.
