The **Committee on Housing, Neighborhood Development and The Homeless** of the Council of the City of Philadelphia held a Public Hearing on **Thursday, February 21, 2008**, and recessed the public hearing until **Tuesday, March 18, 2008 at 10:00 AM**, in **Room 400, City Hall**, to hear further testimony on the following:

**080095** Resolution authorizing the Council Committee on Housing, Neighborhood Development and the Homeless to hold hearings on the problems of foreclosures in Philadelphia and the extent to which sub-prime mortgages contribute to this problem and further investigating the possibility of imposing a Moratorium on Sherriff's Sales on those foreclosures resulting from sub-prime mortgages, and other mechanisms for protecting homeowners from homelessness.
