Recessed Hearing Notice

The **Committee on Law and Government** of the Council of the City of Philadelphia held a Public Hearing on **Tuesday, February 19, 2008** and recessed the public hearing until **Thursday, February 28, 2008 at 8:30 AM**, in **Room 400, City Hall**, to hear further testimony on the following:

- 080008** An Ordinance providing for the submission to the qualified electors of the City of Philadelphia of an amendment to the Philadelphia Home Rule Charter to allow the Administrative Board to increase the number of deputies exempt from civil service in City departments; fixing the date of a special election for such purpose; prescribing the form of ballot questions to be voted on; and authorizing the appropriate officers to publish notice and to make arrangements for the special election.
- 080040** Resolution proposing an amendment to the Philadelphia Home Rule Charter to allow the Administrative Board to increase the number of deputies exempt from civil service in City departments, and providing for the submission of the amendment to the electors of Philadelphia.

Immediately following the public hearing, a meeting of the Committee on Law and Government, open to the public, will be held to consider the action to be taken on the above listed items.
