Honoring The Philadelphia Fraternal Order of Police.

WHEREAS, The Circus consists of 20 separate shows performed at the Northeast Armory and at Broad and Pattison; and

WHEREAS, This year, in an effort to increase the working relationship between the Police and the Community, the Lodge provided each Police District and Unit throughout the City with access to tickets for the Show; and

WHEREAS, Each night a bike was raffled off and the proceeds were given to St. Christopher's Hospital in a special initiative called "Kids Helping Kids"; and
