The **Committee on Parks, Recreation and Cultural Affairs** of the Council of the City of Philadelphia will hold a Public Hearing on **Monday, March 5, 2012, at 10:00 AM, in Room 400, City Hall**, to hear testimony on the following items:

- 120018** An Ordinance naming and designating the "Robin Hood Dell East" located at Ridge Avenue and Huntingdon Drive as the "Georgie Woods Entertainment Center."
- 120045** Resolution calling on the Philadelphia City Council Committee on Parks, Recreation and Cultural Affairs to hold public hearings to determine and identify Parks and Recreation Department resources, along with other City departments' programming, universities, cultural institutions, social and non-profit organizations focused on youth, which can be utilized to aid in the academic enrichment and supplement the academic needs of Philadelphia public school students.
