RESOLUTION

Honoring and Congratulating Meneko Spigner McBeth for winning the 2014 Frito-Lay “Do Us A Flavor” contest

WHEREAS, Meneko plans to use her winnings from Frito-Lay to help pay for the college education of her three daughters; and

WHEREAS, Meneko and her husband Christopher McBeth, a financial analyst for the U.S. Navy, are raising their daughters in Pemberton, N.J., and thus have earned the pride of the Delaware Valley; and
