The **Committee on Streets and Services** of the Council of the City of Philadelphia will hold a Public Hearing on **Thursday, February 28, 2013, at 2:00 PM, in Room 400, City Hall**, to hear testimony on the following items:

- 120658** An Ordinance authorizing 2nd Street Brew House ("Owner") to construct, own and maintain an open air sidewalk café at 1700 South 2nd Street ("Property"), under certain terms and conditions.
- 120961** An Ordinance authorizing the revision of lines and grades on a portion of City Plan No. 195 by striking from the City Plan Webb Street from Albert Street to Huntingdon Street, under certain terms and conditions.
- 130003** An Ordinance authorizing Ruby D, LLC dba Lemon Hill Food and Drink to construct, own and maintain an open-air sidewalk café at 747 North 25th Street, Philadelphia, PA, under certain terms and conditions.
- 130016** An Ordinance amending Section 10-722 of The Philadelphia Code, entitled "Use of Dumpsters," by revising certain requirements for dumpsters and making technical changes, all under certain terms and conditions.

- 130020** An Ordinance establishing a parking regulation on Moore street, north side, 11th street to 12th street.
- 130021** An Ordinance establishing a parking regulation on 12th street, both sides, McKean street to Snyder avenue.
- 130022** An Ordinance authorizing Farhtable LLC to construct, own and maintain an open-air sidewalk café at 824 S. 8th Street, Philadelphia, PA, under certain terms and conditions.
- 130064** An Ordinance amending Section 6 of an Ordinance (Bill No. 120396) approved September 13, 2012, entitled "An Ordinance authorizing Northern Liberties Auction, Inc. ("Owner") to construct, use and maintain various encroachments within the right-of-way on the north sidewalk of Spring Garden Street between N. Third Street and Bodine Street ("Property"), under certain terms and conditions,"

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by extending the period for compliance therewith.
