"Philadelphia 21st Century Minimum Wage and Benefits Standard," by requiring employers subject to that Chapter to provide certain earned sick leave benefits to

employees covered by that Chapter, all under certain terms and conditions.

An Ordinance amending Chapter 17-1300 of The Philadelphia Code, entitled

"Philadelphia 21st Century Minimum Wage and Benefits Standard," by repealing Section 17-1311, entitled "Living Wage Advisory Committee," and by enacting a new Section 17-1311, entitled "Living Wage and Benefits Review Committee,"

all under certain terms and conditions.

An Ordinance amending Chapter 17-1600 of The Philadelphia Code, entitled

"Economic Opportunity Plans," to require that certain economic opportunity plans be submitted to Council and published on the City's website and changing all references from "MBEC" to "certifying agency," as defined; all under certain

terms and conditions.

An Ordinance amending subsection 19-2604(6) of The Philadelphia Code, under

which businesses that enter into agreements to make contributions to community development corporations receive business privilege tax credits, all under certain

terms and conditions.

Immediately following the public hearing, a meeting of the Committee on Commerce & Economic Development, open to the public, will be held to consider the action to be taken on the above listed items.
