## AN ORDINANCE

*THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PHILADELPHIA HEREBY ORDAINS:*

SECTION 1. The following parking regulation is hereby established:

Mole street, west side, Ellsworth street to Federal street.

Monday - Sunday

SECTION 2. The following parking regulation is hereby established:

St. Albans street, south side, 23rd street to 22nd street.

Except RPP #1

SECTION 3. The following parking regulation is hereby established:

Kimball street, south side, 20th street to 21st street.

Two Hour Parking  
8:00 AM - 9:00 PM  
Monday - Friday  
Except RPP #1

SECTION 4. The following parking regulation is hereby established:

Kater street, north side, 21st street to 22nd street.

Two Hour Parking  
8:00 AM - Midnight
