The **Committee on Commerce & Economic Development** of the Council of the City of Philadelphia will hold a Public Hearing on **Monday, October 25, 2021**, at **9:00 AM**, in a **remote manner using Microsoft® Teams**. **This remote hearing may be viewed on Xfinity Channel 64, Fios Channel 40 or <http://phlcouncil.com/watch-city-council/>**, to hear testimony on the following items:

- 210632** An Ordinance amending Chapter 17-1600 of The Philadelphia Code, entitled “Economic Opportunity Plans,” by establishing new definitions and clarifying the manner in which credit is given for M/W/DSBE participation, all under certain terms and conditions.
- 210671** An Ordinance amending Title 9 of The Philadelphia Code, entitled “Regulation of Businesses, Trades and Professions”, by adding a new Chapter requiring certain businesses or professions provide disclosures regarding tangled titles; all under certain terms and conditions.
- 210643** Resolution authorizing the Committee on Commerce and Economic Development to hold hearings on the economic impact of the film industry in Philadelphia.
