In compliance with the Pennsylvania Sunshine Act, Act 93, 1998, the **Committee on Streets and Services** of the Council of the City of Philadelphia will hold a Public Hearing **Thursday, December 7, 2006, at 8:30 AM, in Room 400**, City Hall, to hear testimony on the following items:

- 060890** An Ordinance amending Chapter 12-3000 of The Philadelphia Code, entitled "Use Of An Automated Red Light Enforcement System To Prevent Red Light Violations," by authorizing the installation of red light enforcement systems at the intersection of Mascher Street at Roosevelt Boulevard, and by reducing to sixty days the phase-in period during which only warnings are issued, all under certain terms and conditions.
- 060891** An Ordinance granting permission to Muhammad R. Shaukat, owner and operator of the newsstand located on the southeast corner of Broad Street and Montgomery Avenue, to construct, use and maintain overhead electrical and telecommunications lines from an existing utility pole over and across the public right of way, for the purpose of supplying electrical service and telephone service to said newsstand.

Immediately following the public hearing, a meeting of the Committee on Streets and Services, open to the public, will be held to consider the action to be taken on the above listed items.
