## Public Hearing Notice

The **Committee on Parks, Recreation and Cultural Affairs** of the Council of the City of Philadelphia will hold a Public Hearing on **Monday, October 31, 2016**, at **1:00 PM**, in **Room 400, City Hall**, to hear testimony on the following items:

- 160329** An Ordinance renaming and Designating Daisy Field as "David Montgomery Field" in the City of Philadelphia.
- 160611** An Ordinance officially naming and designating the park and playground area located on 61st Street and Baltimore Avenue, in the City of Philadelphia as "Robert Wilson III Park."
- 160163** Resolution authorizing Council's Committee on Parks, Recreation, and Cultural Affairs to investigate and hold hearings on the preservation and expansion of the City's public art, including its voluminous collection of outdoor murals, mosaics, and sculptures.

Immediately following the public hearing, a meeting of the Committee on Parks, Recreation and Cultural Affairs, open to the public, will be held to consider the action to be taken on the above listed items.
