Recessed Hearing Notice

The **Committee on Commerce & Economic Development** of the Council of the City of Philadelphia held a Public Hearing on **Wednesday, September 24, 2008** and recessed the public hearing until **Wednesday, October 1, 2008 at 10:00 AM**, in **Room 400, City Hall**, to hear further testimony on the following:

080573 An Ordinance amending Chapter 19-2600 of The Philadelphia Code, entitled "Business Privilege Taxes," by expanding the program under which a credit against business privilege taxes is given to certain businesses that contribute monies to community development corporations undertaking economic development activities within the City of Philadelphia; all under certain terms and conditions.

080103 Resolution authorizing City Council's Committee on Commerce and Economic Development to investigate, and to hold hearings on, the issue of diversity within Philadelphia's Building and Construction Trades, and further authorizing the Committee to issue subpoenas to compel the attendance of witnesses and the production of documents and other evidence.

Immediately following the public hearing, a meeting of the Committee on Commerce & Economic Development, open to the public, will be held to consider the action to be taken on the above listed items.
