RESOLUTION

Honoring Author Dr. Sulayman Clark, author of “*The Rains: Voices for American Liberty.*”

WHEREAS, Dr. Sulayman Clark, author, lecturer, and education consultant is a native of Philadelphia who attended Cheyney University of Pennsylvania and earned a Master of Arts from Stanford University in the area of educational administration, planning and social policy; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Sulayman Clark wrote *The Rains: Voices for American Liberty*, an historical novel inspired by the true events and heroism of a remarkable inter-faith and multi-racial group of men and women beginning in the Antebellum period through the Reconstructed era; and

WHEREAS, *The Rains* traces the history of Black education in America, including the quest for educational empowerment and the creation of the nation’s first historically black colleges and universities; and

WHEREAS, The story is based in Philadelphia and most of the novel’s characters were real life “free persons of color” formed a dynamic coalition of social activists who fought to eradicate slavery as a socially accepted and legalized practice; and

WHEREAS, The book has been added to the School District of Philadelphia’s history curriculum, inspiring the students of our great City; and

WHEREAS, *The Rains* is particularly relevant in “the Age of Obama” as it brings history to life in a way that empowers and enlightens the reader; now therefore,

RESOLVED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PHILADELPHIA, That it hereby honors Author Dr. Sulayman Clark, author of “*The Rains: Voices for American Liberty.*”
