The **Committee on Commerce & Economic Development** of the Council of the City of Philadelphia will hold a Public Hearing on **Tuesday, October 6, 2020, at 2:30 PM**, in a **remote manner using Microsoft® Teams**. - 200446** Resolution authorizing the Committee on Commerce and Economic Development to hold a hearing that examine recent research released by Pew Charitable Trusts (“Pew”) and Center City District (“CCD”) on the state of our local business economy, the role our Black-owned and minority-owned businesses play in the City’s economy, and the impact of Covid-19 on these businesses.
