Public Hearing Notice

The **Committee on Public Property and Public Works** of the Council of the City of Philadelphia will hold a Public Hearing on **Thursday, May 22, 2008**, at **1:00 PM**, in **Room 400, City Hall**, to hear testimony on the following items:

- 080319** An Ordinance naming and designating Public Health Center 9 located at 131 E. Chelton Avenue as the "Mattie L. Humphrey Health Center."
- 080402** An Ordinance authorizing the Commissioner of Public Property, on behalf of the City, to enter into an amendment to an existing sublease between the Philadelphia Municipal Authority and the City for the City's use of certain office space located at 100 South Broad Street, under certain terms and conditions.
- 080403** An Ordinance authorizing the Commissioner of Public Property and the Executive Director of Fairmount Park to enter into a temporary easement agreement with the Southeastern Pennsylvania Transportation Authority allowing SEPTA to use portions of 185 West Allens Lane and 7301-7321 Cresheim Road, under certain terms and conditions.
- 080435** An Ordinance authorizing the Commissioner of Public Property on behalf of the City of Philadelphia to transfer to the Philadelphia Authority for Industrial Development, for nominal consideration, a certain parcel of land, with the buildings and improvements thereon, known as 3548 Germantown Avenue, for further conveyance.

Immediately following the public hearing, a meeting of the Committee on Public Property and Public Works, open to the public, will be held to consider the action to be taken on the above listed items.
