In compliance with the Pennsylvania Sunshine Act, Act 93, 1998, the **Committee on Finance** of the Council of the City of Philadelphia will hold a Public Hearing **Tuesday, April 25, 2006, at 10:00 AM**, in **Room 400**, City Hall, to hear testimony on the following items:

- 051105** An Ordinance authorizing the Philadelphia Authority for Industrial Development ("PAID") to file an application with the Office of the Budget, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, under the Redevelopment Assistance Capital Program, in an amount not to exceed Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000) to assist in the development of Moore College of Art and Design; and authorizing the City to enter into an agreement with PAID in furtherance of grant requirements; all under certain terms and conditions.
- 060108** An Ordinance authorizing the Water Commissioner and the Procurement Commissioner, on behalf of the City of Philadelphia, to enter into a Service Contract with the Philadelphia Municipal Authority, pursuant to which the City will assume certain obligations under an agreement that the Authority will enter into with Philadelphia Biosolids Services, LLC to design, finance, build, own and maintain facilities and equipment, and provide operating services, for the management of the City's wastewater treatment solids; all under certain terms and conditions.
- 060109** An Ordinance approving an extension of the term of existence of the Philadelphia Municipal Authority and authorizing the Authority to design, build, finance, own, operate, maintain and lease facilities and equipment, and provide related services, for the management of the City's wastewater treatment solids; all under certain terms and conditions.
- 060185** An Ordinance removing a portion of the property known generally as the Byberry State Hospital from the Philadelphia Keystone Opportunity Zone, subject to the request and consent of the owners of said Property, under certain terms and conditions.

Immediately following the public hearing, a meeting of the Committee on Finance, open to the public, will be held to consider the action to be taken on the above listed items.
