RESOLUTION

Declaring February 14, 2001 as "Firefighters Recognition Day."

RESOLVED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PHILADELPHIA, That we hereby express our gratitude to all our firefighters and fire paramedics in our city and declare February 14, 2001 as Firefighters Recognition Day in Philadelphia.

FURTHER RESOLVED, That an Engrossed copy of this resolution be presented to George Casey, President of the Philadelphia Firefighters Union, as evidence of the sincere sentiments of this legislative body.
