AN ORDINANCE

Amending Section 17-109 of The Philadelphia Code, entitled "Local Bidding Preferences," by increasing the local business preference percentage, under certain terms and conditions.

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PHILADELPHIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

SECTION 1. Section 17-109 of The Philadelphia Code is amended to read as follows:

§ 17-109. Local Bidding Preferences.

* * *

(5) Award of City Contracts.

(a) On any contract for which the City secures competitive bids pursuant to Section 8-200(1) of the Home Rule Charter, the Commissioner shall award a [five percent] ***ten percent (10%)*** bid preference to any Local Business Entity that submits with its bid:

* * *

(b) In determining the lowest responsible bidder on any such contract, the Commissioner shall subtract [five percent] ***ten percent (10%)*** from the bid of any Local Business Entity awarded such a preference, or shall implement the bid preference otherwise pursuant to regulations promulgated by the Commissioner.
