RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, Through its *Career Integrated Learning Advising* model, Graduate Philadelphia expands pathways to learning by addressing barriers faced by underserved communities including basic needs, childcare, financial literacy, digital literacy, and access to comprehensive wraparound services; and

WHEREAS, The organization advances the social and economic mobility of adult learners through higher education degree attainment, workforce advancement, and access to living wage employment opportunities; now, therefore, be it
