AN ORDINANCE			
Amending subsection 9-203 of The Philadelphia Code, entitled "Street Vendors," by permitting vendors licensed to operate on certain City streets from certain otherwise prohibited conduct; all under certain terms and conditions.			
THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PHILADELPHIA HEREBY ORDAINS:			
SECTION 1. Section 9-203 of The Philadelphia Code is hereby amended to read as follows:			
TITLE 9. REGULATION OF BUSINESSES, TRADES AND PROFESSIONS			
* * *			
CHAPTER 9-200. COMMERCIAL ACTIVITIES ON STREETS			

(7) *Prohibited Conduct*. No vendor or person shall:

\* \* \*

(k) leave any conveyance unattended at any time or store, park, or leave same overnight on any city sidewalk or street or at any vending location permitted under subsection (10)(b) hereof, unless *either* the Department approves a Mobile Food Vendor to remain overnight in connection
