Recognizing Mr. Juan "Johnny" Santiago for his dedication and contributions to the successful development of "La Liga Del Barrio" Basketball League.

WHEREAS, With the support of volunteers, parents and corporate sponsors, as Motrin and Old Navy, the by-product of Mr. Santiago's labor is evidenced by the league's recent achievements. "La Liga Del Barrio" has earned membership in the Junior NBA/WNBA and it was chosen as a key participant in the February 2002 All-Star Weekend Jam Session Program. Further, one of the League's players was awarded an Honorable Mention to the National All-Star Junior NBA/WNBA; and

WHEREAS, The leagues upcoming championship game will be hosted by the 76ers' organization at the First Union Center on February 18, 2002; and
