## Cancellation and Rescheduling of Public Hearing

The Committee on Commerce & Economic Development of the Council of the City of Philadelphia has cancelled the Public Hearing on Wednesday, February 28, 2007, at 1:00 PM, and has rescheduled the Public Hearing on Monday, March 12, 2007, at 1:00 PM in Room 400, City Hall, to hear testimony on the following items:

- 070106 Resolution authorizing City Council's Committee on Commerce and Economic Development to hold hearings to examine current invoicing and disbursement procedures and policies in City procurement and contracting, so as to determine measures that may be required to implement and ensure best practices and standards for prompt payment.
