Honoring and congratulating the Frankford High School Baseball team, on their successful 2019 season and conference 11-3 record in the Philadelphia Public League.

WHEREAS, The Frankford High School Baseball team is led by Frankford High School's Head Baseball Coach and Frankford alumni Juan Namnun; and

WHEREAS, This Philadelphia Public Championship League win was the third consecutive title victory as the Frankford Pioneers stood 2nd overall in the Philadelphia Public League Independence Conference and 37th in the Pennsylvania Division AAAAAA in their 2019 season; and
