AN ORDINANCE

Amending Section 14-1402 of The Philadelphia Code, entitled "Parking in Residential Districts," by imposing restrictions on off-street parking in front of residential buildings, under certain terms and conditions.

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PHILADELPHIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

- SECTION 1. Section 14-1402 of The Philadelphia Code is amended to read as follows:
- § 14-1402. Parking in Residential Districts.
- (5) Location of Parking. Parking structures which are attached to the building in any district shall be governed by the same provisions as the building itself. Open-air parking and parking in detached garage structures shall be governed by the provisions set forth below:
 - (a) One-Family and Duplex Dwellings.

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- (.2) Where open air parking is provided:
- (.a) To the rear of the building, it shall be located behind the minimum depth and area required for the rear yard;
- (.b) To the side of the building, the required side yard shall be maintained between such open-air parking and the property line;
