Public Hearing Notice

The **Committee on Public Property and Public Works** of the Council of the City of Philadelphia will hold a Public Hearing on **Monday, March 22, 2010**, at **9:00 AM**, in **Room 400, City Hall**, to hear testimony on the following items:

- 090785** An Ordinance authorizing the sale of City real estate for cash consideration of fifty percent (50%) of its fair market value for the purpose of creating retail and commercial jobs, provided a first-priority lien on the property is retained equal to the difference between fair market value and the cash consideration, extinguishable based on fulfillment of retail and commercial job creation requirements, under certain terms and conditions.
- 100094** An Ordinance authorizing the Philadelphia Authority for Industrial Development (PAID) to purchase approximately 20 acres on Summerdale Avenue between Foulkrod Street and Godfrey Avenue, under and subject to the Philadelphia Industrial and Commercial Development Agreement among the City, PAID, and the Philadelphia Industrial Development Corporation.
- 100101** An Ordinance amending Title 16 of The Philadelphia Code, entitled "Public Property," by setting forth certain requirements for Council's approval of redevelopment proposals and redevelopment contracts submitted to Council for approval under the provisions of the Urban Redevelopment Law.
- 100130** An Ordinance authorizing the Commissioner of Public Property to execute and deliver to the Philadelphia Authority for Industrial Development a deed conveying, for nominal consideration, fee simple title to the parcel measuring approximately 58,402 square feet which is located at 5326 Pulaski Avenue at the southwesterly side of Penn Street and Pulaski Avenue, with the buildings and improvements thereon, for further conveyance at nominal consideration.

Immediately following the public hearing, a meeting of the Committee on Public Property and Public Works, open to the public, will be held to consider the action to be taken on the above listed items.
