AN ORDINANCE

Amending Section 12-701 of The Philadelphia Code, entitled “Designation of Bicycle Lanes,” to authorize a bicycle lane on East Market street from 2nd street to 6th street; and making associated changes to parking regulations within the same limits; all under certain terms and conditions.

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PHILADELPHIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

SECTION 1. Section 12-701 of The Philadelphia Code is amended to read as follows:

§ 12-701. Designation of Bicycle Lanes.

* * *

(2) The Department is authorized to designate a bicycle lane upon the following streets and regulate the operation and use of vehicles and bicycles upon such streets in a manner consistent with Pennsylvania Department of Transportation (PennDOT) regulations:

* * *

() East Market Street, from 2nd street to 6th street: One bicycle lane in each direction, and the removal of a moving vehicle lane on each side of the street within the same limits.*

SECTION 2. The following parking regulations shall be amended on East Market street, both sides, from 5th street to 6th street to:

NO STOPPING ANYTIME

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall take effect as follows:

- (a) Section 1: Immediately.
- (b) Section 2: Upon construction of the Old City Market project with lane changes.
