The Committee on Finance of the Council of the City of Philadelphia will hold a Public Hearing on Wednesday, June 9, 2010, at 11:30 AM, in Room 400, City Hall, to hear testimony on the following items:

An Ordinance amending Chapter 19-2600 of The Philadelphia Code, entitled

"Business Privilege Taxes," by creating the "Philadelphia Internship Tax Credit,"

under certain terms and conditions.

An Ordinance amending Chapter 19-500 of The Philadelphia Code, entitled

"Taxes and Rents -General," by adding a new Section 19-511, entitled "Electronic Payments and Filings," providing for mandatory and voluntary payment by electronic funds transfer and electronic filing, all under certain terms and

conditions.

100307 An Ordinance approving the Fiscal Year 2011 Capital Budget providing for

expenditures for the capital purposes of the Philadelphia Gas Works (including the supplying of funds in connection therewith) subject to certain constraints and conditions, and acknowledging receipt of the Forecast of Capital Budgets for

Fiscal Years 2012 through 2016.

An Ordinance authorizing the Bond Committee to sell bonds at public or private

negotiated sale, to provide funds toward various capital municipal purposes; providing for appropriations to the Sinking Fund Commission for the payment of such bonds; authorizing agreements to provide credit or payment or liquidity sources for the bonds in connection with issuance of the bonds, and certain other actions; providing for obtaining the consent of the electors to increasing the indebtedness of the City; and fixing a day and providing for arrangements for

holding the election for obtaining such consent.

Immediately following the public hearing, a meeting of the Committee on Finance, open to the public, will be held to consider the action to be taken on the above listed items.
