An Ordinance amending Title 19 of The Philadelphia Code, entitled "Finance,

Taxes and Collections," by adding a new Chapter 19-4100, entitled "New Sustainable Businesses," to reduce the tax burden on new sustainable businesses;

all under certain terms and conditions.

An Ordinance amending Chapter 19-2600 of The Philadelphia Code, entitled

"Business Income and Receipts Taxes," to revise the Sustainable Business Tax Credit by changing the criteria for eligibility, by increasing the number of eligible businesses, by increasing the total tax credit amount, and by expanding the credit so that it applies against Sustainable Businesses' total business income and

receipts tax liability; all under certain terms and conditions.

Resolution authorizing the Committee on the Environment to conduct public

hearings to investigate the relationship between poor Indoor Environmental

Quality and high incidences of childhood asthma.

Immediately following the public hearing, a meeting of the Committee on the Environment, open to the public, will be held to consider the action to be taken on the above listed items.
