An Ordinance amending Chapter 10-200 of The Philadelphia Code, entitled

"Ethnic Intimidation and Institutional Vandalism," to clarify and revise its scope

and related penalties, all under certain terms and conditions.

170401 An Ordinance amending Section 17-2102 of The Philadelphia Code, entitled

"Council Review of Contracts with Certain Entities," to restore the exemption from Council review provided in the Home Rule Charter for certain contracts between the City and the Support Center for Child Advocates, under certain terms

and conditions.

An Ordinance amending Section 2-305 of The Philadelphia Code, entitled "Office

of Property Assessment; Chief Assessment Officers; Powers and Duties," by further providing with respect to the manner in which assessments are determined for certain properties that are subject to rent restrictions, affordability requirements and other related restrictions, and for properties with respect to which federal or state income tax credits have been obtained; and by providing for additional reporting requirements with respect to such properties; all under certain

terms and conditions.

Immediately following the public hearing, a meeting of the Committee on Law and Government, open to the public, will be held to consider the action to be taken on the above listed items.
