Public Hearing Notice

The **Committee on Streets and Services** of the Council of the City of Philadelphia will hold a Public Hearing on **Tuesday, October 9, 2018, at 1:00 PM, in Room 400, City Hall**, to hear testimony on the following items:

- 160026** An Ordinance amending Title 12 of The Philadelphia Code, entitled "Traffic Code," Chapter 12-100, "General Provisions," by adding new definitions, and Chapter 12-900, "Parking Regulations and Penalties," by adding "live performing arts venue" to the entities exempt from paying fees for curb loading zone permits and adding a new Section, entitled "Performing Arts Priority Loading and Unloading Zones," providing for loading and unloading zones to allow easier access for performing artists to load-in and load-out at live performing arts venues around the City of Philadelphia; all under certain terms and conditions.
- 171054** An Ordinance authorizing the revision of lines and grades on a portion of City Plan No. 295 by striking from the City Plan Harner Street from Spring Lane to Manatawna Avenue and reserving and placing on the City Plan a right-of-way for sewer and drainage purposes within the lines of Harner Street being stricken and authorizing acceptance of the grant to the City of the said right-of-way, under certain terms and conditions.

An Ordinance authorizing the revision of lines and grades on a portion of City Plan No. 196 by striking from the City Plan Trenton Avenue from Clearfield Street to Allegheny Avenue, under certain terms and conditions.

Immediately following the public hearing, a meeting of the Committee on Streets and Services, open to the public, will be held to consider the action to be taken on the above listed items.
