The **Committee on Public Health and Human Services** of the Council of the City of Philadelphia will hold a Public Hearing on **Thursday, November 19, 2020, at 1:00 PM**, in a **remote manner using Microsoft® Teams**. This remote hearing may be viewed on **Xfinity Channel 64, Fios Channel 40** or <http://phlcouncil.com/watch-city-council/>, to hear testimony on the following items:

- 200403** Resolution authorizing the Committee on Public Health and Human Services to continue to hold hearings to assess the City of Philadelphia's efforts, as coordinated by the Managing Director's Office and human services departments, to prevent and treat abuse, addiction, and disease related to the use of opioids; and to assess the City's response to the 2020 Restorative Investment Plan for Kensington Residents.
- 200520** Resolution authorizing the Committee on Health and Human Services to hold hearings to evaluate the City of Philadelphia's plan for distributing, tracking, and otherwise managing the roll out of the COVID-19 vaccine.
