Public Hearing Notice

The **Committee on Commerce & Economic Development** of the Council of the City of Philadelphia will hold a Public Hearing on **Thursday, March 25, 2021**, at **2:00 PM**, in a **remote manner using Microsoft® Teams**. This remote hearing may be viewed on **Xfinity Channel 64, Fios Channel 40** or **<http://phlcouncil.com/watch-city-council/>**, to hear testimony on the following items:

- 200382** An Ordinance amending Chapter 17-500 of The Philadelphia Code, entitled “Goals for the Participation of Disadvantaged Owned Business Enterprises in City Contracts,” by adding a new requirement that City Council be notified of certain changes to existing City contracts valued over \$1 million to ensure expansions adhere to participation goals and standards, all under certain terms and conditions.
- 210193** Resolution authorizing the Committee on Commerce and Economic Development to hold hearings examining best practices and new ideas for safely reopening the City of Philadelphia’s workspaces including office buildings, City buildings, and other high-risk congregate settings not currently operating at pre-pandemic capacity.
