

AN ORDINANCE

Amending Section 12-701 of The Philadelphia Code, entitled "Designation of Bicycle Lanes," to authorize a bicycle lane on West Market Street from 34th street to 30th street; and making associated changes to parking regulations within the same limits; all under certain terms and conditions.

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PHILADELPHIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

SECTION 1. Section 12-701 of The Philadelphia Code is amended to read as follows:

§ 12-701. Designation of Bicycle Lanes.

* * *

(2) The Department is authorized to designate a bicycle lane upon the following streets and regulate the operation and use of vehicles and bicycles upon such streets in a manner consistent with Pennsylvania Department of Transportation (PennDOT) regulations:

* * *

(*) West Market street, from 34th street to 30th street: One bicycle lane in each direction, and the removal of a parking lane on West Market street, south side, from 34th street to 30th street.

SECTION 2. All existing parking regulations on the following street are hereby terminated:

West Market street, south side, from 34th street to 30th street.

SECTION 3. The following parking regulations are hereby established:

West Market street, south side, from 34th Street to 30th street.

NO STOPPING ANYTIME

- SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect as follows:
 - (a) Section 1: Immediately.
 - (b) Section 2: Upon replacement of parking signage consistent with this Ordinance.
