

#### THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PHILADELPHIA HEREBY ORDAINS:


SECTION 1. Pursuant to Section 14-106 of The Philadelphia Code, the Philadelphia Zoning Maps are hereby amended by changing the zoning designations of certain areas of land within an area bounded by Woodland Avenue, 49th Street, Grays Avenue, and 54th Street from the existing zoning designations indicated on Map "A," set forth below, to the zoning designations indicated on Map "B," set forth below.

### **Zoning Districts**




I-2, Medium Industrial; ICMX, Industrial Commercial Mixed-Use


RM-1, Residential Multi-Family; RSA-2/RSA-5, Residential Single-Family Attached




# **Map B Proposed Zoning**
